SURFACE PREPARATION

Surface must be dry and free of rust, oxide, dirt, dust, grease or wax. For New or Unweathered Plastic Surfaces: Quickly wipe surface with enamel deglosser. For Aged or Weathered Plastic Surfaces: Wipe surface with ammonia based product such as window cleaner.

APPLICATION

Protect surrounding areas with drop cloths. Always apply paint at room temperature (70-80° F). To ensure color uniformity and prevent clogging, SHAKE CAN vigorously for at least two minutes after the mixing ball rattles. Hold can in an upright position 8" to 10" from the object being sprayed. Press spray button firmly. Use steady, even strokes while spraying. Apply multiple thin coats and let dry between each coat to avoid runs and sags.
