Exterior Latex Semi-Gloss House Paint is formulated to provide a quality finish for your exterior house and trim.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Scrape to remove loose, peeling paint and sand smooth. Previously Painted Wood: Remove all loose dirt & chalk. Scrub protected areas under eaves to remove invisible deposits which cause peeling. Remove any mildew using one quart of household bleach in three quarts of water. Rinse thoroughly and let dry completely. Wear goggles and gloves to prevent contact with the bleach. Sand any glossy areas to dull the surface. Caulk cracks and putty nail holes. Spot prime any bare areas with appropriate primer. Previously Painted Masonry: Remove loose or powdery paint & chalk. Spot prime bare areas with exterior primer. Aluminum Siding: Remove all chalk or loose paint. Clean surface thoroughly with trisodium phosphate. Metal Surfaces: Scrape or wire brush to remove loose paint. Spot prime bare metal with the proper Metal primer. New, Unpainted Surfaces: Wood Siding & Trim: Prime bare wood with an alkyd or acrylic primer. Prime hardboard with alkyd primer. Masonry: Newly poured concrete must be cured for at least 90 days. Concrete block should be given two coats of this product. If using a block filler, follow with two coats of this product. Galvanized Metal: Prime with latex galvanized primer. Ferrous Metal: Prime with a red oxide rust inhibiting primer. Bare Aluminum: Prime with an acrylic latex primer.

APPLICATION

Stir thoroughly. Apply generously with nylon or polyester brush or good quality roller. Stop painting at least four hours before nightfall, stopping at the end of a wall or corner. Do not paint when temperatures are below 50°F, in direct sunlight, or before expected rain. On hot days surface may be dampened with water to slow drying. For airless spray application, use a .017 tip at 2,000 psi. If using two or more gallons of the same color, mix together and stir paint thoroughly to make sure color is uniform throughout.
